

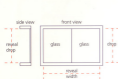
Do it yourself measuring guide

Use a metal measuring tape and let the width and drop be millimetres (mm).

First decide in which of the following two ways you wish to install each window covering.

1. Inset Fit (inside of window)

- this means you measure and install the blind inside the window reveal.



Allow for clearance - deduct from opening sizes the usual allowances as follows:

	width	drop
Vertical Blind	-5mm	-10mm
Venetian Blind	-10mm	-10mm
Roman Blind Facade	-10mm	+50mm
Roller Blind	-5mm	+150mm

(To allow the blind to come past sill and cover the top roller, add 150mm to drop of Roller.)

2. Face Fit (outside window)

- this means you measure and install the blind on to architraves or walls.

a. Measure opening sizes



Allow for clearance - deduct from opening sizes the usual allowances as follows:

		width	drop
Vertical Blind	to floor	+200mm	-10mm
	past sill	+200mm	nil
Venetian Blind		-10mm	-10mm
Roman Blind Facade		-10mm	+50mm
Roman Blind Helicouise		nil	nil
Roller Blind		-5mm	+200mm

(To allow the blind to come past sill and cover the top roller, add 200mm to drop of Roller.)

Roller Blind - choose trim style from trim chart

Venetian Blind - choose control side left or right.

Vertical Blind - choose control side left or right and choose stack side as indicated
